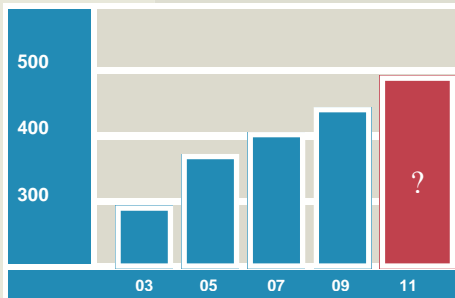

The Carolina Region Provides:

- Up to \$2,000,000 in liability insurance for your facility;
- \$25,000 Secondary Medical Insurance Policy for registered participants;
- Tournament Director Handbook with all the information needed to run the event;
- Certified Officials for all Junior tournaments;
- Staff to accept all tournament entries and pre-tournament administration;
- Website for pools, results, and event communication.

A common misconception we hear is that hosting a Volleyball tournament is too difficult. We are doing our best to ensure that is not the case! Our established guidelines are set up so the event can pretty much run itself. We are here to help you get started.

What does it take to host an Event?

❖ A SITE

Most of our tournaments are held in facilities with two or three courts. The Carolina Region guarantees payment for a minimum of four teams per court at the tournament entry deadline, so tournament directors will usually have between 8 and 15 teams depending on the number



of courts available. Facilities with more than 3 courts may submit to host two or more divisions to maximize your court space.

❖ AWARDS

The Carolina Region pays Tournament Directors approximately \$84 per team (the Tournament Director Handbook provides detailed breakdown of where tournament entry fees are distributed). The only expenses that the Tournament Director is responsible for are the awards (individual awards for first and second place teams) and facility rental costs. The Carolina Region will pay the officials.

For our Regional Championships, the Carolina Region pays for the awards so the Tournament Director is only responsible for the facility rental and running the event.

❖ EQUIPMENT/FORMS

The Tournament Director will set up the facility with all volleyball equipment and like-new USAV-approved volleyballs. Enough scoresheets should be provided for all matches. Results should be tracked in a central location. Our Tournament Director Handbook will have all the forms needed to run the event and we have a section of our website just for Tournament Directors!

❖ MEMBERSHIP

All players, officials, coaches, and tournament directors must be current members of the Carolina Region or USA Volleyball. See our website for information on joining the Carolina Region. Individuals that register online by November 1 receive a discount.

❖ ENTHUSIASM
